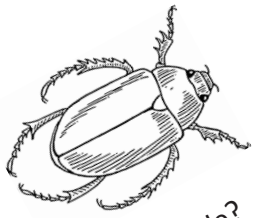


Jewel Beetle Ball Mask



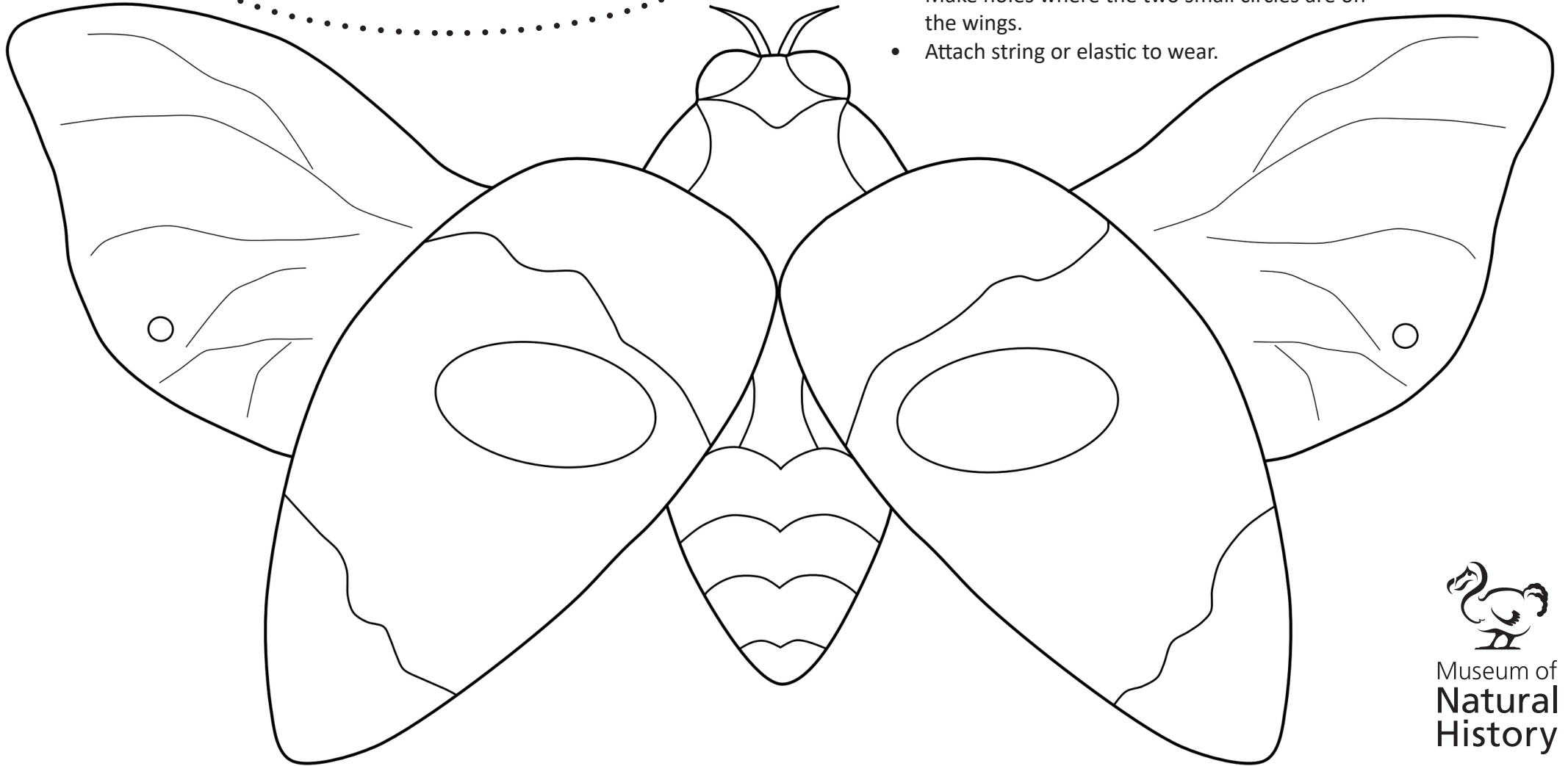
Can you find a jewel beetle?

- Make holes where the two small circles are on the wings.
- Attach string or elastic to wear.
