What you need...

- Paper to print craft onto
- Colouring materials
- Glue
- Scissors
- Strip of white paper for blowhole

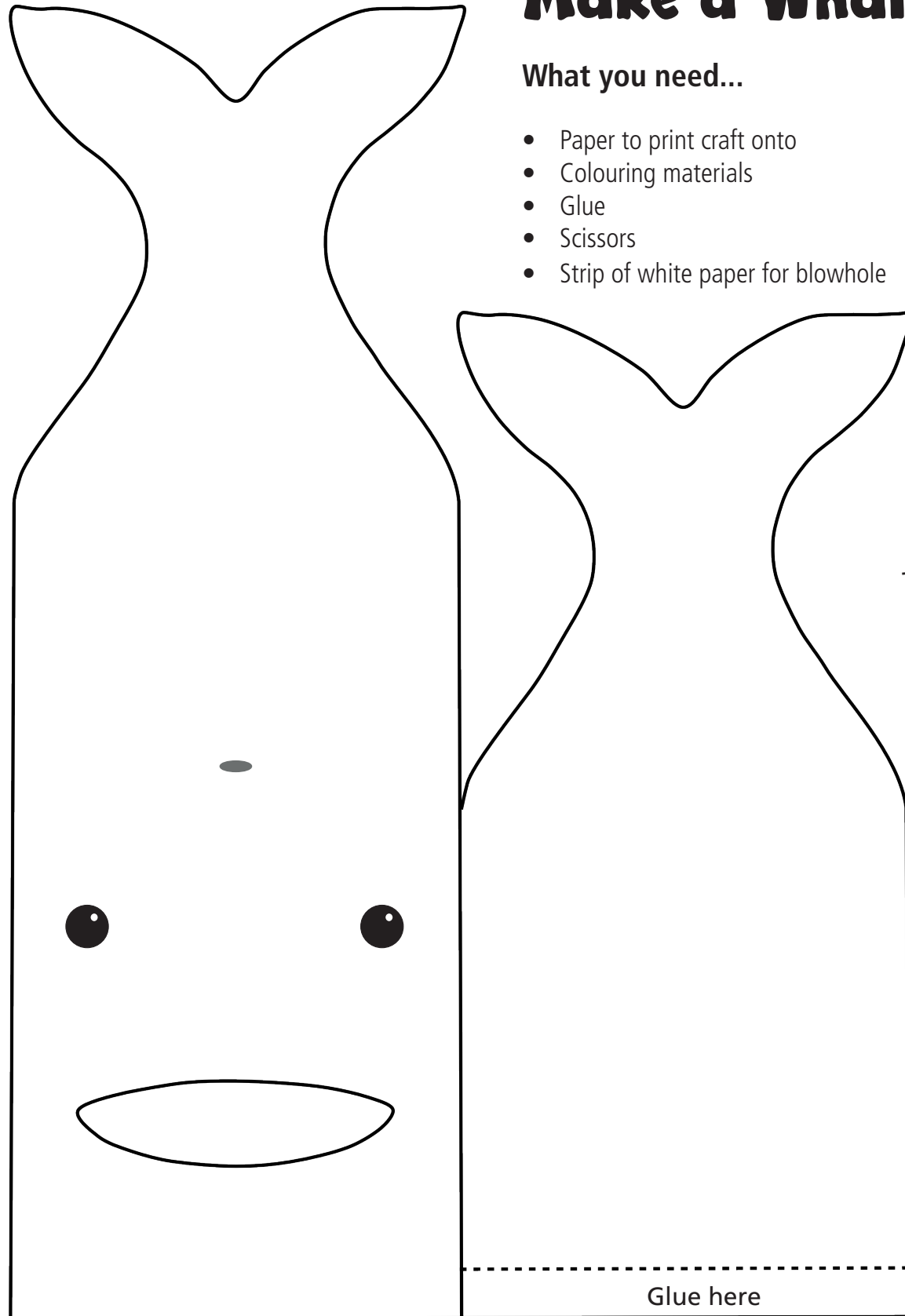
*The whale has
a blowhole
which sits on
top its head...*

*The blowhole
is the whale's
nostrils and
enables it to
breath air into
its lungs...*

*When the
whale comes to
the surface to
breath, it sprays
water from its
blowhole.*

*Fold along the
dotted line*

Glue here



How to make...

- Cut out the two parts of the whale.
- Colour in and decorate.
- Draw some teeth or baleen in the mouth.
- Glue the two parts of the whale together at the folded strip and tail fins.
- Pierce a hole on top of the whale's head (where the small oval is). Take a strip of white paper and cut along the shorter side to create a fringe. Roll-up and poke the fringe into the hole so it looks like the whale is squirting water from its blowhole.
