

Red Kite Mobile

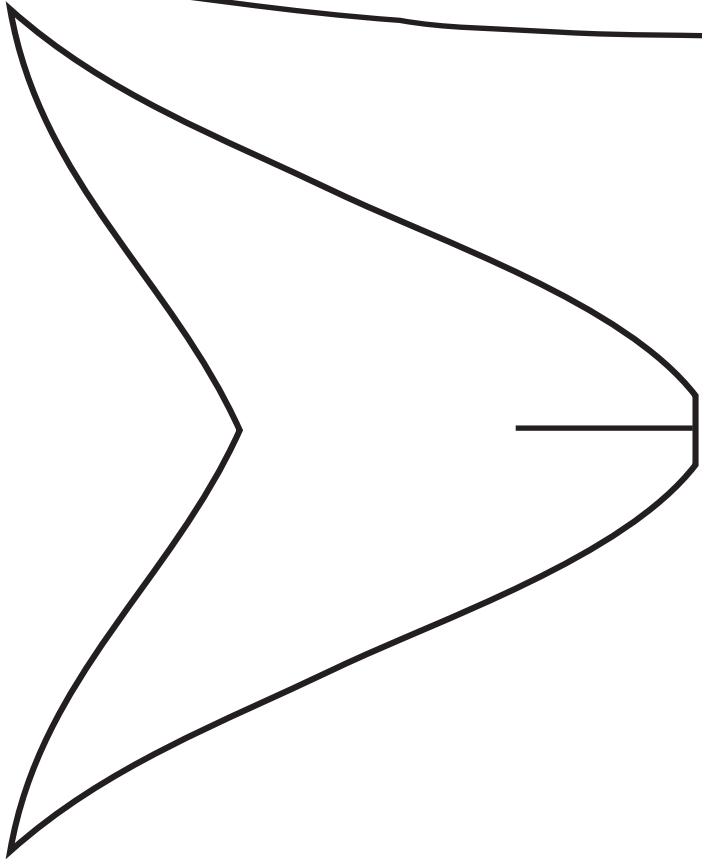
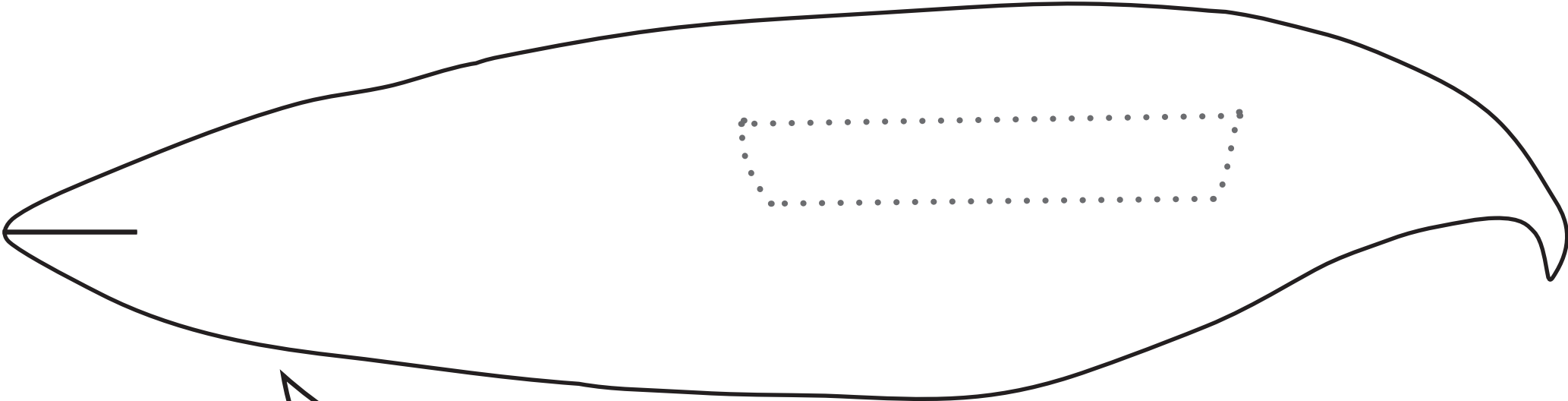
Want it to look like the real thing? Check out the diagram on the back!

1. Decorate your Red Kite however you like.
2. Cut out around the wings, body and tail (including along the little slots).
3. Stick the wings onto the body (use the dotted outline as a guide).
4. Slide the body and tail together. Make it stronger with a bit of tape, if you'd like!
5. Finally, attach some a length of wire to each wing and the tail and stick around some dowelling to complete your Red Kite mobile!
